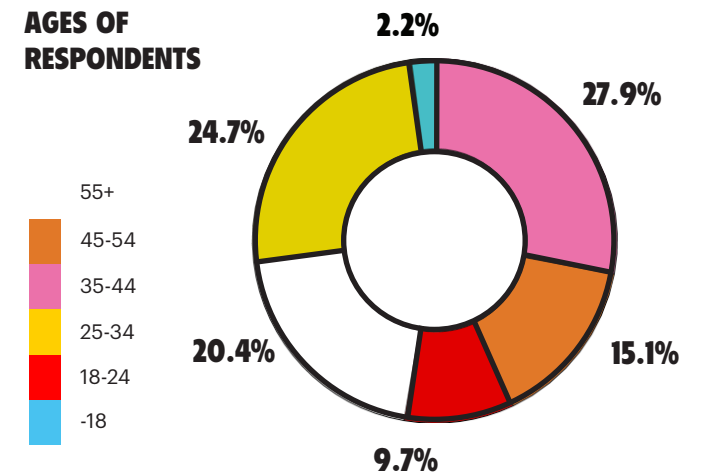

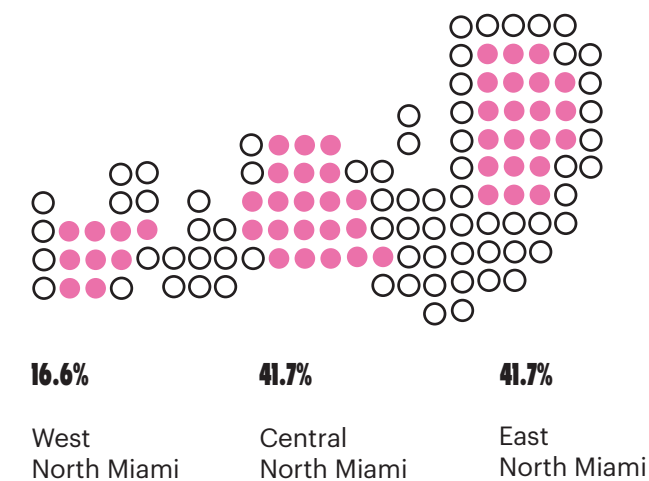
PROSPECTIVE SOLUTIONS

Community Gardens, Walking Paths, and Community Programming were the most desired additions to the neighborhood.

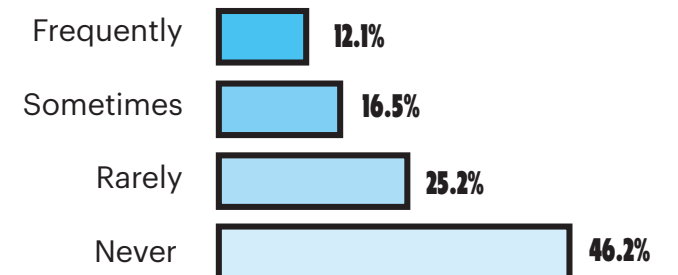
AGES OF RESPONDENTS



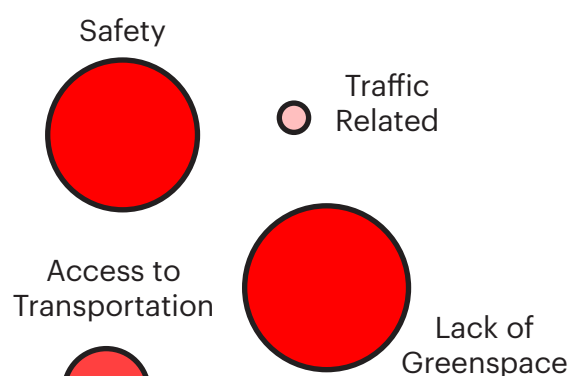
WHERE RESPONDENTS LIVE AND WORK IN NORTH MIAMI
